KG block for Dunkura R/C Primary

A D A M F O GHANA EV, a Germany-based non-governmental organisation, has funded the construction of a two unit classroom block for the kindergarten of the Roman Catholic Primary School at Dunkura in the Bosome-Freho District of the Ashanti Region.

The block, comprising two classrooms, office and a store, with a set of furniture, was provided at the cost of GH¢30,000.
