Madamfo Ghana foundation supports 103 children

A Non Governmental Organization operating in the Volta region, Madamfo Ghana Foundation has presented Christmas gifts to 103 trafficked but rescued children at Kpando.

The welfare package valued at GH¢15,000 comprises 56 suitcases of shoes, cover cloth, christmas dresses, mosquito net, 56 mattresses, books, pens, exercise books and 47 polythene bags, also containing mosquito nets, biscuits, dresses and sweets among others.

Presenting the items, the Country Director of Madamfo Ghana Foundation, Mr. Emmanuel Kumadey said the Foundation had financial assistance from Germany and that it was not a profit making organization.

Mr. Kumadey noted that it was unfortunate that some institutional homes dealing in the welfare of children were exploiting the unfortunate children under their care and advised that those institutions should change their attitudes. The Kpando District Chief Executive, Mr. Francis Ganyaglo commended the NGO for the gesture, which he pointed out would help in the development efforts of the area.
