PRIMARY SCHOOL AND NURSERY SCHOOL KABILE

The R/C Primary School with implemented nursery school in Kabile is in urgent need of a new school building. The current building is ailing and the nursery school is just a tiny ramshackle hut. There is not enough space for the 130 children, so, most of the time, they are forced to study outside. The nursery school is closed throughout the entire rainy season - which of course has negative impact on the children's school performance. In addition to that, there are no restrooms or wells.

We try to improve this situation as fast as we can and thanks to a very generous donation we are able to build a new school building with three classrooms, one office and a storage room. We plan on realising toilet facilities and a water supply system in the second stage of the project.

In addition to that we want to register all the children that were born in huts. Due to these circumstances they are not registered yet and therefor deprived of attending nursery schools or schools.

COSTS: NURSERY SCHOOL: 25,000 EURO
WATER SUPPLY AND TOILET FACILITY: 20,000 EURO
SCHOOL DESK: 30 EURO

The Kabile Presby School doesn't have enough means to afford enough school desks, so most of the 296 pupils have to sit and study on the ground. That is why we would like to equip the school with sufficient school furniture - enough for all pupils and teachers.

WATER - THE SOURCE OF LIFE

In 2018, once again, we were able to build wells in several villages and provide the people with clean drinking water - and there will be further water projects in 2019.

There is no well nearby, so the inhabitants have to fetch their water from remote creeks and rivers. The contaminated water is the cause of numerous severe diseases and the children are constantly in danger of dying from Cholera or other diarrhoeal diseases - but we can save lives by building hand-pump equipped wells.

TOTAL COSTS: 5,000 EURO PER WELL

EMERGENCY AID FOR PHYSICALLY IMPAIRED CHILDREN

In Ghana, it is very hard for children that were born with disabilities. Meeting their special needs is often an impossible challenge for the families. Resignation is the result.

The plight of the children is dramatic. There is a lack of suitable means and for many children, the ground is the only place for them to stay. Contractures, deformities of the bones or pressure ulcers are the consequences. Using the bathroom becomes an ordeal.

Often, these children are completely cut off of public infrastructure, education and information.

We want to take care of these children and improve their situation and lives decisively. Providing suitable wheelchairs with which the children can participate in life and attend school is a first step. Another step is medical care, proper nutrition and other therapeutic approaches, which are also part of this project.

EMERGENCY AID PROJECT

Often, carrying loads on their heads for traders and customers, is the only job for many young women and girls that live in the city of Kumasi.

Many of these young, little girls called “Kayayei” are between 8 and 18 years old. They have moved from the north of Ghana to the south, to work and to escape poverty.

But in most cases, they left one hell just to arrive in another. Their childhood is not a happy childhood, at all. Most of them are living under inhumane living conditions, are victims of sexual violence, verbal and physical abuse and exploitation by their employers and customers.

Many of them live in shabby huts without toilets and sanitation. Of the estimated 35,000 Kayayei that are living in Kumasi, the most vulnerable are children (more than 3,000), adolescents and pregnant girls who sleep in front of shops, in run-down huts or on the streets.



Our project includes measures to reduce the precarious, dangerous and inhuman situation of the most vulnerable Kayayei. For example: access to basic health care, especially for babies and young children; prevention of unwanted pregnancies as a result of prostitution and rape; creation of alternative services such as vocational training, counseling, affordable housing, family tracing and supported family reunification.

FARMLAND


We want the Ghanaian children to be more independent from food donations and in order to do so, we have started a farming project. Throughout the Ashanti Region we can dispose of approx. 6,000 qm of fertile land on which we cultivate maize, cassava, plantains and beans. You can support us by sponsoring one parcel (approx. 12x5m).

With only 10 Euro per month you can cover the entire costs for one parcel: preparation of the arable acreage, sowing, cultivation, harvesting and transport. The land is harvested and farmed twice a year and its ownership is mainly in the hands of locals - which is why your sponsorship does not only provide food, but also jobs.

HOW TO HELP:

- You can support our farming project with 10 Euro per month and “adopt” 10 square metres of arable acreage.
- For only 10 Euro, you can buy a chicken or you can buy a bag of poultry food for 50 Euro.
- Become a sponsor for a child that we freed from slavery at Lake Volta within our programme against child trafficking and child slavery - with only 50 Euro per month.
- Help us cover the running costs of the children's home. With only 15 Euro for a board game, or 25 Euro to afford a school bag or a book for only 8 Euro.
- You can sponsor the primary health care for a new-born with only 10 Euro.
- You can help us to send a nurse to the Kayayei and their children with only 50 Euro.
- Help us dress the children. A full set of clothes, underwear and shoes for a child costs 30 Euro.

- A three-wheeled wheelchair - that would enable a physically impaired child to attend school - costs 300 Euro.

- We are able to teach an entire village in family planning and provide medical trainings - with 400 Euro.
- 5,000 Euro ensure the water supply via a manual well for an entire village.
