CORONA VIRUS – WE HELP, TOO!

The entire world is in a state of emergency, that nobody has ever seen before. The disease COVID-19, which is caused by the Corona Virus has already taken numerous lives all over the world. We are all afraid and try our best to protect our families and also under an economic point of view, it is a challenge to most of us. But, in order to stop the virus from spreading globally, we must work together.

Even at times like these we remain in Ghana and do all we can to fight and to stop the virus. Because Madamfo is the Ghanian word for friend and we will never leave our friends behind!

Our general code of realising projects exclusively with locals has now become a big advantage. We have an outstanding network and are therefore able to respond quickly and efficiently to any unforeseen changes. We know the Health-Departments and Administrations very well and they depend on us now.



Why is COVID-19 such a threat for people in developing countries?

There is no functioning health-care-system in Ghana. There is a lack of hospitals, medical staff and necessary equipment – and almost no ventilators. There are no adequate facilities to test people for COVID-19 and there are no facilities at all to treat patients appropriately. Poor families cannot afford health care at all.

There is also a large number of people with heavy pre-existing conditions that – in large parts – have not been treated appropriately. Diseases like pneumonia, tuberculosis, as well as HIV are widely spread. And in addition to that there are diseases such as malaria, meningitis, typhoid fever and cholera.

The virus can have devastating effects on the villages without infrastructure, and we want to do our best to prevent the people from that – with your help!

WHAT DO WE DO?

Prevention saves lives!

In Ghana, the virus can lead to humanitarian crisis which the country has never faced before – but we do anything in our power to prevent that from happening.

This is why we support approximately 500,000 people in Ghana with the following measures:

1. Information campaigns and awareness-raising campaigns

Our trained staff (nurses and social workers) are on site and inform the people about necessary hygiene-measures – such as proper hand-washing and explain the necessity of social distancing. This can happen via radio-campaigns or via cars with speakers on their roof. That way you are able to inform and keep the social distance at the same time.

2. Veronica-Bucket-Kits

We are in urgent need of bin sets with which you can soap-wash your hands running water. That is the only way to enable the people put the hygiene-recommendations into practice. And as of right now – that is the only way to stop this pandemic from moving on. Please be aware, that there is no general water supply system throughout Ghana.

3. Provision of so-called PPE – personal protective equipment

Our staff, nurses and social workers, do anything in their power to stop the virus from spreading and to protect the people. But their protection must be ensured, too. And the only way to protect the helpers is by equipping them with the right tools, such as face masks or gloves.

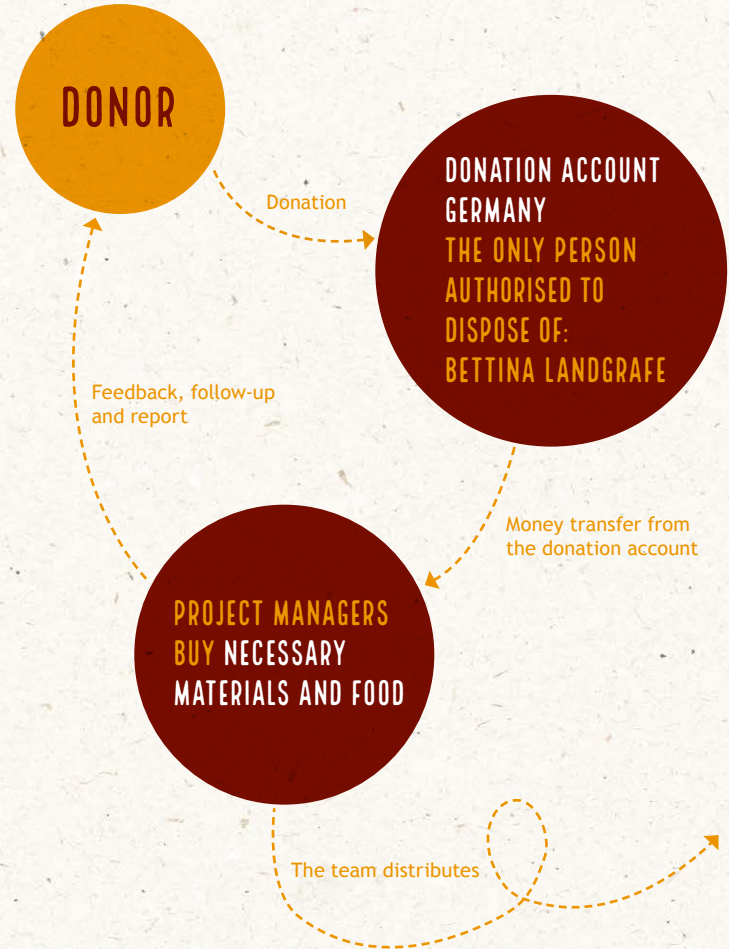
And that is the only way to help navigating through the situation, despite of the lock-down and current challenges.

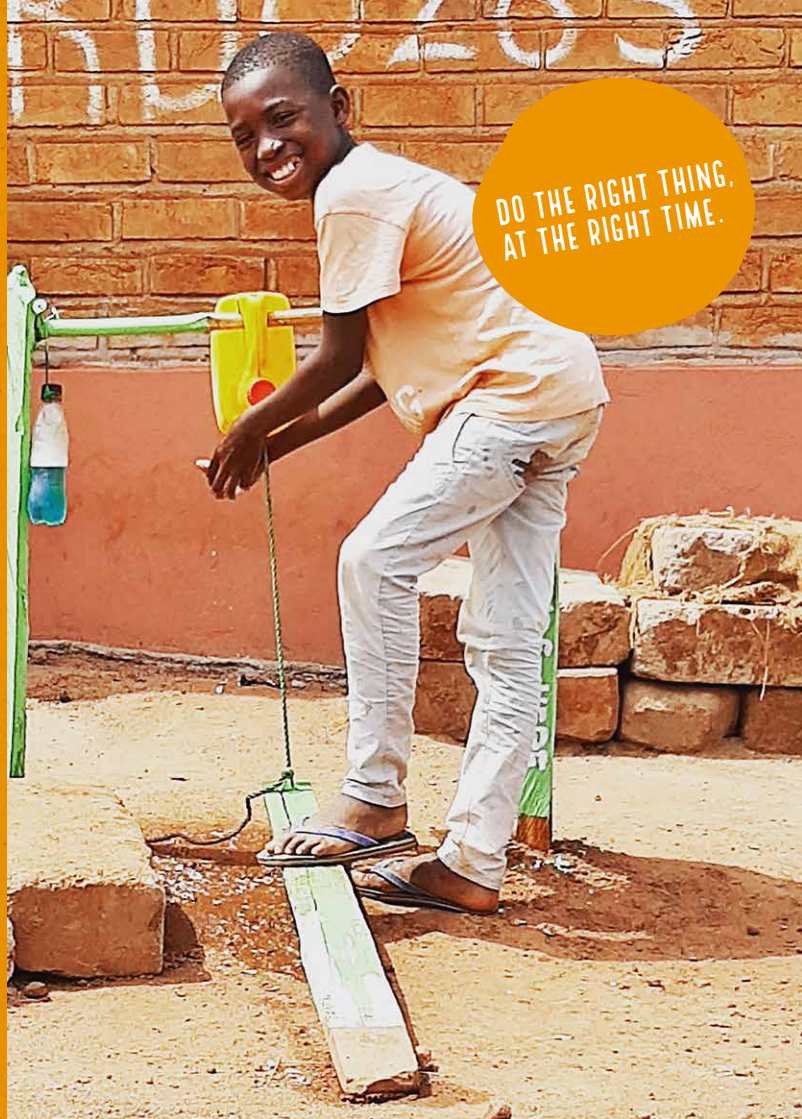
