NEWS FROM HO

Thanks to the generous donation from Sternstunden e. V. we were able to extend our Children's Home in Ho with a new Kindergarten and a new playground, suitable for small children. In addition, new cots were purchased and the fence wall around the playground was raised. This contributes to a safe environment for the smallest children and provides them with age-appropriate care.

The Children's Home itself also needed some repairs and additional maintenance after all these years. Thanks to your numerous donations, amongst others for our Christmas fundraising campaign, we were able to provide new metal beds and mattresses for all the children, replace broken doors and buy urgently needed new kitchen appliances.



A NEW CLINIC FOR PRAPRABABIDA

Praprababida is located in the Central Region of Ghana and is home to approximately 2,500 residents. The area lacks essential infrastructure and a proper road network. In the past year, we were able to construct a mechanized borehole in Praprababida, providing the community with access to clean drinking water.

The nearest medical facility was situated at an approximate distance of 15 kilometers. This geographical remoteness posed a formidable challenge for pregnant women and young children, rendering their access to healthcare impractical. They sought medical care at the clinic only in cases of severe illness and even that posed a challenge sometimes.

Consequently, this circumstance had profound implications for maternal and neonatal mortality rates, which were already elevated in this particular region. The absence of comprehensive family planning education and counseling further exacerbated the issue, resulting in a notable incidence of teenage pregnancies. With the establishment of the new Outreach Clinic for Maternal and Child Health, we aim to address the significant maternal and child mortality rates. This facility will provide prenatal check-ups for expectant mothers and children, administer vaccination campaigns, and facilitate childbirth services. Additionally, it will host regular awareness campaigns and counseling sessions, including those pertaining to family planning.

The total cost for this initiative amounts to 37,000 €



WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF A LONG-TIME FRIEND

Our benefactor, Jerome Evans, whose generous support has allowed us to successfully implement several projects in the past, recently spearheaded a fundraising campaign alongside friends and family. In a remarkably short span of time, they collected such a substantial amount that we can now bring to life not one, but two educational projects.

On the one hand, a new school building with sanitary facilities and a borehole for the Ewusiejoe Girls Junior Highschool is being built in Ewusiejoe Biakakrom.

On the other hand, we can now provide another Junior Highschool in Attakrom, situated in the Bono Region. In 2018, Mr. Evans had collaborated with us to establish a Kindergarten and a Primary School in Attakrom.

Recently, the school reached out to us with a pressing request. There are currently 66 students attending the Junior Highschool, but there is no available space within the Primary School building to accommodate them. Consequently, the school has requested an expansion of their facilities. At present, these students are attending classes in makeshift outdoor shelter conditions.

Construction work has already commenced on both schools, and we anticipate that the new facilities will be made available to the children later this year.

Costs: Ewusiejoe Girls Junior Highschool: 86,500 € Attakrom Junior Highschool: 49,300 € (Sanitation facilities and a borehole are already in place here.)

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NEW SPACES FOR AKETE'S YOUNG LEARNERS


"We are delighted to have an exceptionally committed partner, the Reiner Meutsch Foundation Fly & Help by our side for the implementation of further educational projects. Together with Fly & Help, we have successfully realized eight school projects to date. We would like to briefly introduce our current collaborative project in Akete":

The community of Akete, located in the Bono Region and comprising approximately 3,500 residents, possesses an educational complex encompassing a Preschool, Primary School, and Junior Highschool. However, currently, only the Junior Highschool students have access to a permanent, brick-built school building. Preschool and Primary School students are accommodated in a makeshift wooden structure, which is incapable of shielding them from rain, dust, or stray animals.

Moreover, there are no toilet facilities or access to clean drinking water, resulting in deplorable sanitary conditions. Diseases stemming from the inadequate hygiene conditions are rampant.

Through our partnership with Fly & Help, we are embarking on the construction of a new school block in this area, featuring six classrooms. Additionally, we will be constructing a sanitary facility with clean toilets and handwashing stations, along with an independent





mechanized water supply system.

This collaborative effort with Fly & Help allows us to establish a suitable learning environment for Preschool and Primary School students. It will help reduce illnesses and absences due to inadequate hygiene and contribute to enhancing basic education in Akete.

Project Cost: 81,200 € Project Status: Currently in progress

WE ARE SOWING THE SEEDS OF THE FUTURE - JOIN US!

Since the early 1990s, Ghana has lost 30% of its forests, leading to severe consequences for both nature and the population. Drought and desertification continue to encroach upon the land, causing more and more people to lose their livelihoods. Poverty and despair have driven many of them away from their homes: into overcrowded urban slums, exploitation, dependency, or the clutches of extremist paramilitaries.

In an effort to halt these devastating consequences, we initiated a sustainable long-term project in 2019: the reforestation of the northern savannah zone of Ghana. The first phase of the project requires the planting of 50,000 new trees to provide realistic self-help assistance. This is coupled with active participation from the local community, involving children, youth, teachers, selected schools, and their families in every step, from planting to nurturing young trees.

Collaborating with village communities, we work on solutions for agriculture and alternative sources of income. We prioritize the empowerment of girls and women, who often bear the brunt of rural migration and exploitation.





At this juncture, we are in need of an additional 30,000 € to establish this project on a sustainable, long-term basis and provide the people with a genuine sense of permanence. This is why supporting this project holds a special place in our hearts.
