YOUR TRUST, OUR RESPONSIBILITY: SUSTAINABLE AID THAT LASTS.

What makes us special? Madamfo Ghana is not only registered as an association in Germany, but also as an official organization in Ghana. This allows us to work directly with the government and receive valuable support – for example, land for projects or staff for schools, kindergartens, and clinics.

The result: Donations are used specifically for the construction and implementation of new projects, not for ongoing operational costs.

Sustainability that works:

- ✓ After completion of our projects, the Ghanaian state provides the necessary staff – teachers, educators, and medical professionals – and handles hiring and payment.
- ✓ Communities take over operation and maintenance of water projects and sanitation facilities after project completion. Early involvement and training ensures local know-how develops and stays in the community.

This means help lasts long after we've moved on. Your support goes exactly where it changes lives. Trust is built through action, not just words.

EVERY DROP COUNTS. WATER CHANGES EVERYTHING.

Our core competencies:

- → Constructing water projects and sanitation facilities
- → Hygiene and awareness programs
- → Sustainable water supply solutions

Why it matters:

Without clean water, health, education, and economic development are out of reach. Many families fetch water from polluted ponds or rivers – with serious consequences such as cholera or worm infestations, which can be life-threatening for children.

Our WaSH projects:

- → Water & Sanitation facilities improve hygiene and reduce diseases.
- → Health means education: fewer absences in school and work.
- → Sustainability through responsibility: communities maintain facilities.

Impact so far:

- → 180 Water projects 450,000 people benefit
- → 47 Sanitation facilities









EDUCATION CREATES OPPORTUNITIES. TOGETHER INTO THE FUTURE.

Education is the key to a self-determined life. But for many children in Ghana, it's out of reach. Missing infrastructure, overcrowded classrooms, and poor state of facilities make learning difficult.

Where schools lack toilets and clean water, especially girls suffer – often missing classes during their menstruation. Without safe, hygienic toilets, they stay home. We attach sanitation and water projects to schools, ensuring dignity and regular attendance.

Our solutions:

- → Building schools and kindergartens safe places for the youngest learners.
- → Providing school materials and furniture because learning needs resources.
- → Promoting training programs future prospects for young people.

Impact so far:

- → 29 Schools
- → 16 Kindergartens

Every school, every desk, every book makes a difference. Together we enable education that lasts.





ENABLING HEALTH - SAVING LIVES.

Medical care should never depend on money.

In Ghana, illness often means more than suffering – it can be life-threatening. In rural areas, lack of medical care turns treatable diseases into deadly threats.

We provide care by:

- → Building Hospitals and Maternity wards.
- → Funding treatments and surgeries for those who cannot afford them.
- → Promoting prevention and awareness.

Impact so far:

→ 19 Medical facilities – over 400,000 people benefit

To ensure that no one is left behind, we focus on sustainable solutions – with every bit of support, we build a better healthcare system that is here to stay.









SOWING THE FUTURE. SUSTAINABLE SUPPORT THAT TAKES ROOT.

Real help must create long-term perspectives. Our reforestation project combats desertification, restores fertile land, and offers people reasons to stay in their communities.

Visionaries are people who plant trees even though they know they will never sit in their shade.

»We sow the future« - more than just planting trees.

Desertification is increasing in Ghana, and fertile land is being lost. Many people see no other option than to move to overcrowded cities – often with no prospects. With our reforestation project, we are bringing back vegetation and creating prospects for people to stay. With just € 1 per seedling, this future can grow.

Bee Project – Empowering Women

Women in self-help groups gain income, independence, and influence through beekeeping – a true example of sustainable empowerment.

Future cannot be given as a gift - but together we can shape it.





CHILDHOOD SHOULD NOT BE FOR SALE. TOGETHER FOR CHILDREN'S RIGHTS AND AGAINST EXPLOITATION.

On Lake Volta, children lose their childhood, working on fishing boats instead of going to school. Hunger, fear, and violence replace safety and learning.

A vicious circle of poverty and hopelessness

Many families give their children away in the hope that they will have a better life elsewhere. But instead, they end up in a life of deprivation – without protection, without education, without a future.

Our Initiative against Child trafficking

We are committed to ensuring that children can grow up free, safe, and full of hope:

- → Rescuing and protecting affected children giving them a safe home.
- → Education as a fresh start every child deserves a place in school.
- → Awareness and prevention break the cycle of poverty with families and communities.





A child belongs in a loving environment—not in the hands of exploiters.

Together, we can change lives, preserve childhood, and give hope. With a so-called place sponsorship, you can provide a safe haven for a child in our children's home.

Your support finances a place for children who, for example, are taken in during emergencies or rescued from situations of abuse. In doing so, you help to provide these children with everything they need and give them protection, security, and a new perspective.







WE GIVE CHILDREN A FUTURE

Every child deserves protection, opportunities, and hope.

Children should laugh, learn, and grow up carefree. But for many in Ghana, childhood means survival. Poverty, violence, and exclusion rob them of any prospects.

No child should have to fight for their dignity:

We support:

- → Girls and young women in Kumasi many work as porters for minimal pay and sleep unprotected on the streets. We provide safety, education, and a chance at a better life.
- → Children with disabilities our special wheelchair design gives them mobility, independence, and access to education.

Freedom of movement for children with disabilities

For many children with disabilities, everyday life is one obstacle after another. Without support, they are often unable to attend school. Our aid fund gives them mobility and, with it, a measure of freedom. With specially designed wheelchairs, they can finally move around independently, participate in classes, and shape their own futures.

Together, we can protect them – and give them hope.





A FULL PLATE -A BETTER DAY.

Our School Feeding Programs ensure hundreds of children get a warm, nutritious meal daily – cooked by women from the community with locally sourced ingredients.

We provide healthy meals

- → Daily school meals: So children can learn and grow strong.
- → Cooked by women from the community: Using ingredients from local markets.
- → Sustainable agriculture: Our farming and fishing project helps families become self-sufficient.

Impact so far:

→ 4 villages – over 690 children benefit

Food means more than just being full – it gives you strength, health, and security.

€ 9 ensure a schoolchild has a daily meal for one month.



SOWING THE FUTURE

€ 1 plants a tree in our reforestation project.
