OUR PATH TO SUSTAINABLE NUTRITION

Grow Ghana stands for hope through self-grown food and for the belief that sustainable nutrition emerges where knowledge, responsibility, and practical action come together. The project combines open-field farming, greenhouses, hydroponics, and aquaponics into a living system that empowers local people.

In the fields, regional crops grow in harmony with soil and climate.

In the greenhouses, harvests are possible even when rainy seasons fail or become too intense.

Hydroponic systems save water and open up new ways of growing food, while aquaponics connects plant cultivation and fish farming in a closed, sustainable cycle.

Grow Ghana is more than food production. It creates reliability, builds knowledge and perspectives, reduces dependency, and gives families the opportunity to actively shape their own future. Sustainable, practical, and carried forward together.

CHARITYMANUEL ACADEMY PROJECT

ENABLING EDUCATION AND SECURING FUTURE OPPORTUNITIES

The CharityManuel Academy Project is a joint initiative of Madamfo Ghana, the local project partner in Tsito, the CharityManuel Academy, initiated by Sabine, who worked there as a volunteer, and the RTL Foundation – Wir helfen Kindern. The aim is to provide children in the community of Tsito in the Volta Region with access to safe, high-quality education.

The CharityManuel Academy is a central place of learning for many families. However, there is currently a lack of suitable classrooms, sanitation facilities, and adequate equipment. Lessons are partly held under provisional conditions, which makes learning difficult and negatively affects the children's health.

As part of the project, a ten-classroom school building with an administrative unit will be constructed, complemented by modern sanitation facilities as well as school furniture and teaching and learning materials. At the same time, a local committee will be trained to take responsibility for the care and maintenance of the buildings.

The close cooperation of all partners ensures that the project does not only create infrastructure, but has a lasting and sustainable impact.

RENOVATION OF THE PLAYGROUND SURFACE AT THE CHILDREN'S SHELTER HO


The playground at the Madamfo Ghana Children's shelter Ho is a central place for movement, interaction and everyday play. After many years of intensive use, the ground had become worn and posed a safety risk.

Through targeted renovation measures, the playground surface was completely renewed. The new ground now provides a safe base for playing, running and learning through movement. Falls are cushioned, the risk of injury is reduced and freedom of movement is improved.

The renovation is a concrete contribution to greater safety and well-being at the children's shelter. The work was carried out with local workers, and future care and maintenance will be managed independently in the shelter.

TOAMFOM A SUCCESS STORY SINCE 2021

What began as an under-resourced rural school has developed into a fully functioning educational centre. Toamfom clearly demonstrates how long-term commitment, reliable partnerships and joint action can create tangible and sustainable impact.

Implemented measures at Toamfom School:

- Construction of a Junior High School block with three classrooms, a staff room and an office
- Renovation and re-roofing of the existing primary school buildings
- Rehabilitation of a storm-damaged primary block in 2025
- Furnishing of all classrooms with school furniture
- Establishment of a fully equipped ICT room for digital education
- Construction of school toilets and an independent water supply
- Upgrading of the school grounds and tree planting as part of our “Sowing the Future” project

Impact in numbers:

Today, Toamfom School offers a complete educational pathway from kindergarten to Junior High School. Student enrollment has increased steadily over recent years and is expected to exceed 250 pupils by 2026. Growing parental trust, improved learning conditions and more stable working conditions for teachers demonstrate that these investments have long-term impact and sustainably strengthen the school.

BAMBOO BUILDS FUTURE



With BAMBOO BUILDS FUTURE, we are creating a sustainable alternative to conventional wooden school furniture. Instead of tropical hardwood we use bamboo, a fast-growing, locally available resource that protects forests, creates jobs and at the same time improves learning conditions for children.

The project brings together education, environmental protection and local value creation, demonstrating how sustainable solutions can be implemented in a very practical way on the ground.

At the same time, BAMBOO BUILDS FUTURE is a forward-looking approach with significant impact. Step by step, we are expanding the use of bamboo with the clear goal of completely phasing out the use of wood in our projects. In this way, the project serves as a model for how responsible construction, environmental protection and education can work hand in hand over the long term.

And the impact is already visible: we are currently producing bamboo school desks for three schools. Delivery is scheduled for the first quarter of 2026, marking an important milestone on the path towards durable, environmentally friendly school furniture made in Ghana.

EWUSIEJOE MATERNITY CLINIC A SAFE PLACE FOR CHILDBIRTH AND PRENATAL CARE

In Ewusiejoe, a rural community in Ghana's Western Region, access to medical care for women was limited for many years. Pregnant women had to travel long distances for antenatal check-ups and childbirth, often under difficult and risky conditions.

With the construction of a maternity unit at the Ewusiejoe Health Center, this gap in care is now being closed. In the future, women will be able to receive medical care locally, give birth safely and attend regular antenatal services. In addition, accommodation for medical staff is being built to ensure continuous and reliable care for the community.

This project lays the foundation for greater safety, dignity and health for women and at the same time strengthens medical care across the wider region in a sustainable way.

FANTEKROM SAFE CHILDBIRTH AND FAMILY PLANNING FOR THE FUTURE

In Fantekrom, a rural community in Ghana's Western Region, reliable medical care for pregnant women and young mothers was lacking for a long time. Antenatal check-ups and childbirth meant long journeys for many women – often under difficult and risky conditions.

With the construction of the maternity clinic in Fantekrom, this has fundamentally changed. Today, there is a permanent facility providing antenatal care, safe deliveries, medical support for mothers and newborns, as well as family planning services. The high level of use shows how urgently this clinic is needed and how strongly it is embraced by the local population. It has become a central place of medical care and hope for families across the region.



Project costs: appr. € 46,000.-





Accommodation for medical staff

To ensure that this level of care can be maintained reliably in the long term, medical staff must be present on site. Without accommodation close to the clinic, it is almost impossible to retain qualified professionals over time or respond quickly in emergency situations.

The construction of four simple staff housing units with electricity and water supply is planned.

DZILAKORPE A SUCCESS STORY AGAINST ALL ODDS

Dzilakorpe is located on a remote island in the Volta Lake. There is no road network, no medical care and hardly any reliable schooling options for children. When people fell ill, they had to hope for the best. Pregnant women were often left on their own. Children grew up without a place where learning was simply part of everyday life.

Building a health facility and a school under these conditions was anything but easy. Every piece of construction material, every bed, door, school desk and medical device had to travel a long way: first by truck, then by ship and finally by boat across the lake. Weather conditions, water levels and distances determined the rhythm of the work.

And yet, it was achieved. Because we have the know-how, resilience and experience to turn even seemingly impossible projects into reality.

Today, Dzilakorpe has a fully functioning health facility with residential accommodation for medical staff. Pregnant women can give birth safely, people who are ill receive care close to home. At the same time, children now have reliable access to education and a permanent place to learn.

These two projects show what is possible when you don't wait for perfect conditions – when people take responsibility, go the extra mile and remain committed even when the path is especially challenging.

MEAL PROGRAMS

With €9, you can provide one schoolchild with one hot meal a day.



SOWING THE FUTURE

With €1, you can donate a seedling to our project "Sowing the future – harvesting prospects."



EDUCATION

€50 provides a child with all their school notebooks for a year.
With €30,000, we can build a kindergarten.





HEALTH

With €400, we can provide medical training to an entire village, teach family planning, and thus reduce maternal and newborn mortality.

A small health center can be built with €35,000.

A mechanized water supply for a larger village or small town can be implemented for around €8,000.



HYGIENE AND WATER

For €5,000 or more, we can build a manual well and supply a small village with clean drinking water.


Enables year-round cultivation of fresh vegetables, regardless of dry seasons or unpredictable weather.
